Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 & 3 to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with their junior (respondent No.4) w.e.f. 07.02.2013. Further prayer is for directing the respondents to give seniority benefits to the petitioners by making necessary corrections in the Seniority List (P-4).

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 12.05.2021 (P-9) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of

respondent Nos.1 to 3 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 12.05.2021 (P-9) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks from today.
