The case has been taken up for hearing through
video-conferencing.

Petitioners have prayed for issuance of
necessary directions to the official respondents for
protecting their civil/personal rights and liberties from being
invaded by the private respondents. Petitioners are alleged
to have solemnized marriage on 27.07.2021 on attaining the
age of majority. They feel reasonable apprehension and
threat perception at the hands of the private respondents
and pray that their personal/civil rights be not violated by
them.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioners have approached the Superintendent of Police, District Faridkot/respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 27.07.2021 (through courier).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3. He submits that the statement of the parties have been recorded by the police wherein respondents No. 4 to 7 have stated that they will not interfere in the matrimonial affairs of the petitioners. After being fully satisfied, the petitioners have also made a statement that they do not require any protection. Still this Court deems it appropriate that in case the petitioners feel any threat perception at the hands of private respondents they may move an appropriate representation before respondent No. 2. In case of filing of such a representation respondent No. 2 would pass necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against any of the parties, if they are involved in any other case. It would be appreciated if the needful is done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
