Instant petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.PC for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 in case FIR No.24 dated 01.03.2020 under Sections 354-A and 354-B IPC registered at Police Station City-2 Abohar, Fazilka.

Learned State counsel has invited the attention of this Court to the affidavit filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Abohar, District Fazilka on behalf of respondent No.1. He has reiterated the submissions made in the said affidavit by stating that no complaint was received by the police from the prosecutrix with regard to her being threatened and subjected to harassment subsequent to the grant of bail to the petitioner vide order dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-2). He further submits that in fact subsequent to the filing of the instant petition seeking cancellation of bail, an inquiry was carried out and allegations of threat and

harassment, which have been levelled by the prosecutrix against the accused, were found to be false.

In the wake of submissions made by learned State counsel, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner, prayer was made by the learned counsel for the petitioner to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail the alternate remedy as may be available to her in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
