Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents to place the petitioner at appropriate place in the final Seniority List dated 16.12.2019 (P-7) and to regularize his services, who is working since 1996 on daily wage basis.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the grievance raised in the Legal Notice dated 12.04.2021 (P-8) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 12.04.2021 (P-8) in accordance with the Policy, framed by the State Government up to date, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks from today.

In case there is a failure, petitioner would be at liberty to initiate the proceedings against the erring officials/officers concerned.
