The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.53 dated 26.04.2021 registered under Sections 326, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 08.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 30.07.2021 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the parties appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala, submitted his report

along with copies of statements of the parties vide letter No.157 dated 01.09.2021 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide endorsement No.14305/RICT dated 07.09.2021.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala, is satisfied that compromise effected between the parties is genuine, outcome of free consent of the parties and is without coercion from any quarter.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala, dated 01.09.2021 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.53 dated 26.04.2021 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, qua the petitioners only.
