Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for counting the entire daily wage services of the petitioner rendered before his regularization for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 27.04.2021 (P-11) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 27.04.2021 (P-11) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 04 (four) months from today.
