The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.249 dated 13.09.2020, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 336, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sirhali, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of 05 days in registering the FIR. He also contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and the complainant had later stated that he had wrongly mentioned Gurjit Singh instead of the petitioner Daljit Singh. It is alleged that the injury for which offence under Section 326 IPC has been invoked, is on the right elbow of the complainant.

This Court, by order dated 07.09.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Parkash Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 07.09.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
