LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

It is submitted that now the petitioner and earlier her predecessor-in-interest were in possession of land measuring 108 kanals 13 marlas, which has been described in the petition, in the capacity of Dholidar since number of years. Predecessors-in-interest of the petitioner are reflected to be in possession of the said land as Dholidars since 1928 as per the record. Petitioner, it is stated, was successfully registered under the scheme of Meri Fasal Mera Beaura in the year 2019. However, when she tried to register herself again under the Scheme now, she was unable to do so with the message flashed on the portal that the land in question belongs to Panchayat/Government of Haryana, therefore, details cannot be entered on the portal without permission of the Deputy Commissioner. Learned counsel submits that representation was submitted before the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri on 31.03.2021 (Annexure P8) but to no avail.

At this stage, learned counsel for respondent No. 2 to whom advance copy of the petition, has been supplied submits that forum for redressal of the grievance has been provided in the Scheme itself attached as Annexure P2 with this petition. As per Clause 7A of the Scheme, District Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted in the District with the Deputy Commissioner of the area as the Chairman. It is stated that petitioner's grievance can be addressed by the said Committee.

Keeping in view the above but without any expression of opinion, it is directed that representation dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P8) be placed before the District Grievance Redressal Committee, which shall take a final decision thereon within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
