This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detenues mentioned in para No.4 of the petition from illegal custody of respondent No.4.

This petition is disposed of with the direction to District Magistrate, Tarn Taran, to enquire into the averments made in the present petition and submit a report to this Court, who shall also exercise powers vested in him/her under the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976.

Copy of this order be handed over to learned State counsel for onward transmission and compliance to District Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
