Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ, especially in the nature of *habeas corpus* directing respondents No.2 to 4 to get detenue-Japleen Kaur released from the custody of respondents No.5 and 6.

It is the case of the petitioner that her marriage was performed with respondent No.5-Jigarjeet Singh on 15.12.2016 and from the said wedlock, a girl child(detenue) was born on 20.02.2018. As per the assertion of the petitioner, respondents No.5 and 6 forcibly and illegally kept the minor girl and threw away the petitioner from the matrimonial home on 21.08.2020.

Vide order dated 29.10.2020 passed by this Court, the matter had been relegated to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the parties had been directed to appear there on 17.11.2020.

As per the report, the matter stands compromised between the private parties and pursuant to the settlement, the petitioner-wife and respondent No.5-husband have started residing together.

In view of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
