Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.81 dated 18.06.2021, under Sections 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (apprehension of adding offence under Section 326 IPC), registered at Police Station City Batala, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury which has been attributed to the petitioner is on the non-vital part of the body. He also contends that the petitioner was having an affair with the daughter of the complainant and 15 days prior to the occurrence i.e. on 01.06.2021, the complainant and his sons had caused injuries to the petitioner and his family members.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he, who was armed with a *datar*, along with other co-accused had given several blows to the complainant and his family members. It is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner used to harass the daughter of the complainant. The injury which is attributed

to the petitioner was on the arm of the complainant with a *datar* and had resulted in a fracture.

In view of the serious allegations against the petitioner of having assaulted the complainant and his family members, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the petition stands dismissed.
