Learned counsel representing the complainant has informed that no application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. or under Section 311 Cr.P.C. is pending and that the complainant shall not indulge in any dilatory tactics.

In view of the aforestated position wherein the trial is virtually at its fag end, this Court does not deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner at this stage.

Needless to mention, the trial Court shall take all such necessary steps as may be possible for concluding the trial expeditiously provided the accused themselves could not cause delay.
