Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.1 and 2 to enquire into the complaint dated 24.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) and registering FIR against private respondents.

Learned counsel contends that private respondents were working with him and the research work and drawing done by the petitioner has been misused by his employees, who have initiated their own work, therefore, they have committed a crime. He submits that representation dated 23.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) has been given to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar for registration of case against them but no action has been taken upon the same, therefore, he prays for issuance of necessary directions.

After hearing learned counsel and considering the prayer

made in the representation, this Court is not inclined to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C as the petitioner can avail the alternative remedy.

Dismissed.
