The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned punishment order dated 06.11.2020 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.4 without specifying the currency and time period i.e. without cumulative effect or with cumulative, in violation of Regulation 4 of the Canara Bank Officer Employees' (Discipline and Appeal) Regulations, 1976; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that the statutory appeal against the punishment order dated 06.11.2020 passed against the petitioner, is already pending before the appellate authority. At this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the statutory appeal within a time bound frame.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to take a conscious decision upon the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
