This is a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of the case FIR No.27 dated 23.03.2021 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 307, 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC and subsequently added Section 302 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran, to some other senior police officer not below the rank of IPS.

On 03.08.2021, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Although the petition has been filed seeking directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of case in

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FIR No.27 dated 23.03.2021, registered for offences under Sections 307, 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 was added later on), at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) to some other senior police officer of the rank of IPS, but the counsel confines his prayer to a direction to the official respondents to file a status report regarding the investigation, conducted in the FIR.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. Upon instructions, from ASI Narinder Singh, he submits that 7 out of 9 accused have been arrested and the challan has been presented on 23.06.2021. He seeks and is granted time to file an affidavit, whereas counsel for the petitioner also seeks adjournment to verify this factual position.

List on 25.08.2021.”

On the next date, the affidavit was filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police and, thereafter on 29.10.2021, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Even today, nobody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has submitted that challan has already been presented in this case and out of 09 accused persons, 07 have been arrested.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the

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present petition is dismissed.
