This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.96 dated 21.03.2020, under Sections 21(C), 27-A & 29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for more than 6 months, since 27.05.2021.

[3]. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that no direct recovery was effected from his client in the present case, and that his name has transpired from the disclosure statements of the co-accused persons, namely, Sunil, Suraj and Gurjeet. Sunil and Suraj have already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-36773-2020 on 04.10.2021 and CRM-M-46315-2021 on 10.12.2021, respectively.

[4]. After completion of investigation, Challan against the petitioner has already been submitted but the Trial is yet to commence. As

such, his further detention for an indefinite period is not called for.

[5]. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, his prayer for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
