Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.82 dated 30.06.2021 under Sections 458, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 03.08.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioners were granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 03.08.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Subhash Chand, submits that during investigation petitioner No. 1-Lakhmi Chand has been found innocent and petitioner No. 2 Sunil Kumar has joined the investigation and that they are now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 03.08.2021 granting *ad-interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
