Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion as Lecturer (English) with effect from 30.05.2008 when respondents No. 4 to 7 who are alleged to be juniors to the petitioner were promoted on the same post.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 10.06.2021 (P-12) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice (P-12) in
