Learned State counsel has referred to the status report filed by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Central), Ludhiana, which is taken on record. He submits that earlier the parties have filed a civil dispute which is still pending between them. Now, in the enquiry, it has come that the petitioner and the respondent No.5 are in the habit of entering into quarrel with each other.

It has been specifically mentioned in the status report that there is no threat perception to the petitioner from respondent No.5.

Given above, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh in case any threat perception arises.

Consequently, nothing survives in the present petition and is dismissed as having been withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. However, it shall be open for the petitioner to approach this Court again in case of any threat perception or to inform the concerned SHO.

It is clarified that withdrawal/disposal of the present petition will not come in the way of filing of fresh petition.
