Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 209 dated 23.06.2021 registered under Sections 307, 458, 323, 325, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the no injury has been attributed to the petitioner as petitioner was alleged to be armed with sword and there is no injury on the person of the complainant-victim and there is two days of delay in lodging the FIR.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel while opposing the prayer for bail vehemently contends that as per the MLR, there are two punctured wounds on the person of complainant-victim which can be caused with the sword.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The allegations against the petitioner are very serious in nature. The victim is still in PGI and many other criminal cases are pending against the petitioner.
