The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is that though the petitioner has completed 10 years of service on the post of Frash-cum-Cleaner, her services have not been regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that in this regard a legal notice dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) was also sent to the respondents, however, no response has been received *qua* the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner further limits his prayer in the present writ petition and states that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.1 to take a time bound decision on the legal notice dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Goel, Standing Counsel for UCO Bank accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection if the present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.1 to

decide the legal notice dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) in a time-bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent no.1 to take a decision expeditiously, in accordance with law, *qua* the legal notice dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) sent by the petitioner, and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
