The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the proceedings under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, are pending at Ludhiana.

Per contra, learned counsel representing the respondent has pointed out that the marriage between the parties took place in the year 2014 and the petitioner left the company of the respondent in the year 2016.

He further contends that the proceeding under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, has been filed in the 2021 only to create a ground for transfer of the petition.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to transfer the petition is made out.

Dismissed.
