This application is for placing on record the corrected memo of parties.

Learned counsel for the applicants/petitioners contends that inadvertently, the name of respondent No.4 had been wrongly mentioned.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Heard. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and amended Memo of Parties is taken on record.

Main case

The petitioners are seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger from respondent No.4.

It is stated in the petition that the petitioners have performed their marriage, which is against the will of private respondents and they have apprehension that the private respondents might cause physical harm to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn my attention to the representation dated 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioners to respondent No. 2 –Superintendent of Police, Hisar.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Keeping in view the mandate of the Supreme Court in the case of **“Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another”, JT 2006 (6) SC 173**, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2–Superintendent of Police, Hisar, to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion with regard to the validity of the marriage has been expressed in this order.
