Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant/release the arrears of salary to the petitioners in view of the circumstances explained in the petition.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 09.05.2021 (P-8) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the respondent(s) to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 09.05.2021 (P-8) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 04 (eight) months from today.
