This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Pursuant to the order dated 07.12.2020 passed by this Court, learned State Counsel has forwarded through e-mail a status report by way of affidavit dated 04.01.2021 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tarn Taran , District Tarn Taran.
