GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Juber Belt No.507, stated to be aged 29 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reappoint/enroll the petitioner on the post of Home Guard, along with further relief as mentioned in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the same/similar grievance as made in the present writ petition, the petitioner had got served a legal notice on 02.07.2021 (Annexure P-6). It has been *inter alia* submitted that petitioner was enrolled as Home Guard in the department in the year 2013. It is further submitted that vide memo dated

03.03.2021 (Annexure P-5), the Director General Home Guards & Director Civil Defense, Haryana had issued appropriate directions, but inspite this, the same have not been implemented till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Safia Gupta, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the Authority concerned/respondent No.2, to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of ***three*** months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
