The grievance of the petitioner in this case was that he was not awarded additional marks for his educational qualification of post-graduation (M.Sc.) in terms of the conditions prescribed in Advertisement No. 3/2018 dated 16.04.2018 for selection to the post of Constable (Male) General Duty in Haryana Police Force.

While so, the Secretary (Legal), Haryana Staff Selection Commission, filed a reply stating that upon re-examination of the documents submitted by the petitioner at the time of scrutiny, he was found entitled to allotment of additional three marks for his post-graduation

qualification, as his certificate was prior to the cut-off date. The Secretary further stated that re-scrutiny of all the candidates for the post in question was being conducted and in the event the petitioner came within the zone of consideration, he would be considered for selection and appointment.

In the light of the aforestated stand taken by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, the grievance of the petitioner stands settled.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
