The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner claims to be a resident of Village Kahlwan, Tehsil Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur. Through this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks the following substantive reliefs:-

“A) writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents no. 1 to 4 to carry out the demarcation of street/road encroached by respondent no.5 and take appropriate legal action against respondent no.7 for allowing encroachment on public street/ road by respondent nos. 5 and 6 and failing to comply with the directions of respondent no.4 AND

B) Further directions to respondent no. 1 to 4 to carry out necessary action/ demarcation to clear the illegal and unauthorized possession of

respondent No.5 and 6 from the common street/
passage/road of village Kahlwan, Tehsil Dasuya,
District Hoshiarpur.”

Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, AAG, Punjab, enters appearance on
behalf of the State of Punjab-respondent no. 1 to 4 and on instructions
from Sh. Balwinder, Panchayat Officer, Block Tanda, District
Hoshiarpur, states that the Gram Panchayat is now prepared to get the
demarcation carried out. She submits that the concerned Tehsildar has
been nominated to carry out the demarcation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is
rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also
disposed of.
