Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6, who had forcibly sent him to private De-addiction Center against his wishes and are not allowing him to enter the house.

Learned counsel has argued that respondent Nos.4 to 6, who are parents and grand father of petitioner respectively, are not allowing him to enter the house. In this regard, a representation/complaint dated 26.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2, but till date, no action has been taken upon the same. He prays that necessary directions be issued for providing protection to him.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that the contents of the representation do not indicate that the private respondents are doing any thing wrong or illegal with the petitioner and seem to be acting in reforming him. The representation reads as under:

*“It is requested that I Jagdish Singh son of
Rachhpal Singh am resident of Village Gharangna, District*

Mansa. It came to the knowledge of yourself that my age is 26 years. My parents and my grandfather unnecessarily harass and humiliate me. They said to me that you have drink liquor and they have sent me to D-Addiction Centre where they have harassed me unnecessary. I have not any addiction of liquor. My parents and my grandfather unnecessarily harass and humiliate me knowingly. In future any mis-happening happen with me then my parents and my grandfather are fully responsible for the same. I hereby requested that appropriate action be taken.”

Considering the above, no case is made out for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
