The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Defendant no.1-petitioner has filed this revision petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, assailing the correctness of the order passed by the learned trial court, while dismissing an application for permission to lead additional evidence in order to produce mutation no.4195, 4196, 4480 and 4795 as also a copy of the latest jamabandi.

It is well settled that mutations are entered only for fiscal purposes and do not confer any right. The learned trial court, on appreciation of the material on record has found that the defendant has failed to make out a case for leading the additional evidence. The court has also found that defendant no.1 and 2 had knowledge of the Will dated 19.01.1973 and the mutations sanctioned on that basis.

The suit in question was filed in the year 2013.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

Hence, dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also
disposed of.
