1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.127 dated 23.10.2018 registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana.

2. By an order dated 29.10.2020, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.
