1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 and not to interfere in the personal life of the petitioner or to harass and cause any harm to the petitioner.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted a representation Annexure P-2 dated 27.7.2021 to respondent No. 2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala but no action has been taken on the same till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-2 dated 27.7.2021 and protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

4. Notice of motion to respondent No. 2 only.
5. Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice and on perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. Accordingly, in the light of position noted above, the criminal writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No. 2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-2 dated 27.7.2021 by taking into account all aspects of the matter including the prayer of the petitioner for grant of protection of life and liberty and take such action in respect thereto as may be warranted in law in the facts and circumstances of the case as expeditiously as possible.
7. Petition stands disposed of with the abovesaid directions.
