Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to make necessary correction regarding Date of Birth as well as father's name in the Matriculation Certificate of petitioner bearing Roll No. 2222082.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 & 2, on instructions, submits that a short affidavit of Sh. Sanjeev Sharma, Assistant Secretary, CBSE, Office at Mohali has been filed.

A perusal of paragraphs No.2 & 3 of the said affidavit reveals that “the matter has been re-examined and the desired correction has been accepted by the competent authority regarding which letter & e-mail dated 10.08.2021 are sent to the petitioner”. It further finds mention in the affidavit that “fresh certificate after making the desired correction shall be issued on submitting the original

certificate along with required fee as already intimated to the petitioner vide letter and E-mail dated 10.08.2021”.
