1. Whether reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondent No.1 to provide complete medical record of the treatment of petitioner's mother admitted at Medanta The Medicity Hospital, Gurugram.

Mr. Bhan, learned senior counsel for respondent No.1 submits that entire record of the treatment of petitioner's mother has been sent at the

residential address of the petitioner, through courier and has been received by Ms. Anamika on her behalf. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner and her husband, both are present in the hospital all the time and the record has deliberately not been handed over to them in the hospital itself. He further submits that the entire medical record of the petitioner's mother be made available.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that another copy of the same shall be made available to the petitioner, if she so desires, at the office of the Medical Superintendent of respondent No.1 at 6.00 p.m. today itself. It is further submitted that medical record has never been withheld. The same was supplied as and when asked for and in future also, medical record pertaining to petitioner's mother shall be made available to the petitioner within the time limit as prescribed under the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations, 2002.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed, at this stage. Needless to say that medical record of the patient be made available by the hospital authorities, as and when sought as has been stated on its behalf.

This writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
