This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7 and to take action on representation dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 23.07.2021 to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Roopnagar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/4, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar, to look into and decide representation dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
