Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.95 dated 30.03.2021 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 307, 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Derabassi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aged about 62 years and as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Manpreet Singh, when he along with his father, brother and brother-in-law were present in their fields, accused persons, around 20 in number, came and caused multiple injuries with their respective weapons like gandasi, rod, sword and danda. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are

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that he has caused an injury to one of the victim with a stick, which hit on the left arm.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from SI Narender Kumar, submits that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner is aged about 62 years of age and the injury attributed to him is simple in nature, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
