By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.138, dated 23.05.2020, having been registered at Police Station B-Division, District Amritsar, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914.

Pursuant to the previous orders passed learned State counsel today submits, on instructions, that the petitioner having joined investigation again, presently at least his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

That being so, since the investigating agency itself did not require the custodial interrogation of the petitioner, this petition has been rendered infructuous, and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
