The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of Anticipatory Bail to the petitioner in FIR No.65 dated 27.06.2021, under Sections 458, 323, 34 IPC, (Section 459 & 325 IPC added laterron), registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

This court on 05.08.2021 had made the hereinafter directions upon the Investigating Officer.

“In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail by the arresting officer/investigation officer on furnishing of bail bonds by him to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C. failing which he shall not be entitled to the protection of interim anticipatory bail allowed to him.”

Today the learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab on instructions received from ASI Gurdev Singh, Police Station Maur, District Bathinda, submits that the bail applicant has made full cooperation in the investigation conducted by the Investigating Officer into the offences

constituted in the FIR concerned. Moreover he states, that no further

cooperation of the accused-bail applicant is required by the Investigating Officer, in the latter making further investigation into the offences constituted in the FIR. Therefore, the order made on 05.08.2021 is made absolute. The Investigating Officer concerned is directed to forthwith ensure the furnishing before him of personal and surety bonds by the bail-applicant, in a sum of Rs.25,000/- each.

Moreover, in case any further cooperation of the bail-applicant is required by the Investigating Officer in the latter conducting further investigation, thereupon the Investigating Officer shall through a written *Hukamnama* being issued upon the bail-applicant, shall solicit his presence before him.

The present petition stands disposed off.
