Writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been filed, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears of pay for the post of Welfare and Record Security Incharge.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 06.11.2020 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Sunint Kaur, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 06.11.2020 (P-5), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from today.

It is clarified that in case, legal notice is pending with the Chief Secretary, Government of Punjab, the same be forwarded to the concerned authority forthwith, for compliance of the direction of this Court.
