The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.378 dated 15.05.2019 registered under Sections 302, 201 IPC at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

The petitioner is being tried for murder and admittedly, in such trial, 17 out of the 20 prosecution witnesses have already been examined.

In the light of the above, at the fag end of the petitioner's trial, it is not desirable that he be enlarged on bail especially when he is being tried for an offence of murder and it is so ordered. However, subject to the petitioner's cooperation, the Trial Court is directed to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial within four months from the date next fixed before it.

The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
