LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for directing the official respondents to provide security and protect the life and liberty of petitioners, who are stated to be under grave threat at the hands of private respondents, who are allegedly in connivance with respondents no.7 and 8.

Learned counsel for the State, to whom an advance copy of paper book has been supplied, on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar, Police Station Bilaspur, informs that 04 FIRs have been registered on the complaint of petitioners, the details of which are as under:-

1.	FIR No.160 dated 11.05.2020, registered under Sections 379, 511 IPC, P.S. Bilaspur, District Gurugram.
2.	FIR No.98 dated 16.03.2020 registered under Sections 506, 427, 34 IPC, P.S. Bilaspur, District Gurugram.
3.	FIR No.194 dated 07.06.2020 registered under Sections 147, 148, 323, 325, 307, 365, 379B, 506 IPC and 25.54.59 of Arms Act, P.S. Bilaspur, District Gurugram.
4.	FIR No.513 dated 04.11.2020 registered under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC, P.S. Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the State further submits that necessary action has been taken by the official-respondents on the complaint/s of the petitioners and all allegations of inaction on their part are denied. Learned counsel for the State further points out that civil litigation between the petitioners and respondents no.9 and 10, who are none other but the son and daughter-in-law of petitioner no.1 is pending.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, no further orders are called for in this petition at this stage. Needless to say, in case, any apprehension to their life and liberty is addressed by petitioners, same shall be looked into by the official respondents and necessary action, if any/as may be required, be taken in accordance with law.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
