The prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of Arms License and the fact that application has not been entertained having been filed on 29.08.2018 (Annexure P-1).

In compliance of order dated 15.10.2020, the State of Haryana has filed its reply that the application of the petitioner for issuing Arms License was rejected on 30.03.2019 (Annexure R-1) under Section 13 (2A) of the Arms Act, 1959, on the basis of the verification report submitted by Superintendent of Police, Charkhi Dadri, dated 11.10.2018.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be given liberty to challenge the said order in accordance with law.
