Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.4, namely, Baljinder Singh, SHO, Police Station Khilchian, Tehsil Baba Bakala, District Amritsar and respondent No.5, namely, SI Tejpal Singh, Police Station Khilchian, Tehsil Baba Bakala, District Amritsar are not permitting the petitioner to harvest the fodder crops sown on the land in his possession regarding which there is an agreement to sell in his favour as the vendor Dharam Singh after taking the sale consideration has also delivered possession to him.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 17.07.2021 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law expeditiously and to

take necessary action as has been required in the facts and circumstances of the case.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 17.07.2021 (Annexure P-5) be sent to respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
