The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.172 dated 04.06.2017, registered for offences under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that she does not want to press the instant petition and she has instructions to state that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and file a petition for seeking regular bail.
