The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.100 dated 04.09.2020, registered for offences under Sections 307, 336, 325, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Kot lse Khan, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not want to press the instant petition and the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and file a petition for grant of regular bail.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today. In case he does so and files a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide the same within a period of one week from the date of its filing.
