**G.S. Sandhawalia, J. (Oral):-**

Counsel for the petitioners only presses the alternate prayer made in the present writ petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for transfer to District Rohtak, the preferred district.

It is the case of the petitioners that they were appointed in the year 2011 and working as JBT teachers in the respondent-Department at their respective schools at District Jind. For the on-line transfer policy 2016 (Annexure P-1), they had taken part and filled for various stations within Rohtak. They were entitled for the benefit of marks being a widow and a divorcee and also on account of being female members of the cadre. It is their case that as per the transfer order dated 23.08.2019 (Annexure P-2), which is now being implemented qua the JBT teachers, persons with lower merit have been given the stations in Rohtak district, whereas the petitioners, whose scores would come to 62.0466 and 58.4, have not been considered. It is submitted that representation dated 17.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) has also been filed with the respondents but to no avail.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Nain accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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Keeping in view the limited controversy, this Court does not feel it necessary to call upon the respondents to file reply, as it would only delay the decision making process.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of, with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 17.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) within a period of 2 weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are found entitled for the said relief, they be duly considered. In case there is some legal impediment and the relief is to be denied, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioners.
