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ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very threshold, submits that pursuant to the institution of proceedings before this Court, the salary of the petitioners have been paid during pendency thereof. However, she submits that petitioners apprehend that they may once again be driven to needless litigation in future. Being group 'D' contractual employees through outsourced service provider they, in any case, get almost less than half of the salary being drawn by regular employees and, therefore, they can ill afford another round of litigation. She submits that there should be a blanket direction to the official respondents to pay the salary on due date every month in future.

Heard. Such a blanket direction, as aforesaid, cannot be issued on mere apprehension as expressed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

However, writ petition is disposed of with an expectation that respondents shall ensure that petitioners are paid their salaries on due dates in future, provided of course, if they render commensurate service for the period qua which salary is payable to the petitioners.

Disposed of accordingly.
