The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail during the pendency of Criminal Appeal No.1090 of 2018 titled as “Sham Lal Versus State of Punjab” (Annexure P-3), which is pending before the Court of Ld. ASJ, Patiala, filed by the petitioner against the judgment and order of conviction dated 13.11.2018 passed by JMIC, Patiala (Annexure P-2) in case FIR No.159 dated 25.04.2013, registered for offences under Sections 419, 420, 464, 465 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Tripuri, Patiala (Annexure P-1).

Having argued the petition for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with the submissions made, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not want to press the instant petition. He, however, has instructions to state that the petitioner will surrender before the Appellate Court on or before 16.08.2021.

Dismissed as not pressed.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the Appellate Court on or before 16.08.2021, joins the proceedings and files an appropriate application, the Appellate Court shall make an endeavour and decide the same within a period of one week from the date of its filing.
