Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.72 dated 23.05.2020 under Sections 21, 22, 25, 29 and 61 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Sections 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Mehal Kalan, District Barnala.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that after completion of investigation, the final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C stands filed before the trial Court, however, the same is yet to be considered.

The sole ground raised by the petitioner to claim that police has falsely implicated him on the basis of the disclosure statement made by the co-accused is not worth acceptance, particularly when

there is no challenge to the final report. Even the copy of the same has not been placed on record.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
