AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 57 dated 27.5.2021, under Sections 307 and 427 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

As per FIR, there was a dispute between the family members with regard to the parking of tractor, the matter turned ugly. The petitioner hit the family members of the complainant with the tractor and injuries were sustained by some of the members.

Good sense prevailed over the parties, they have bridged their differences. In view of the factual background and later development it is not a case where custodial interrogation is required.

The petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to his joining investigation within one week. In the event of arrest, he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He is directed to join investigation as and when called for. He shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.

In case of failure of the petitioner to join the investigation, the State would be at liberty to file an application for recalling of the order.
